

Adverbs Modifying Verbs with Helping Verbs

When an adverb modifies a verb that has a helping verb, the adverb modifies the helping verb + the main verb.

- Examples:
- I am slowly walking down the road.
 - He quietly (did tiptoe) up the stairs.
 - Mrs. Adams did thoroughly enjoy her vacation.
 - We were slowly driving in the snow-storm.
 - The class (is traveling) soon to Canada.
 - We (have been) secretly stealing cookies.
