

## ADVERB QUIZ INFO

QUIZ THURSDAY, 3/2

You will have to do the following:

\*Identify adverbs and the verbs they modify. Remember, when an adverb modifies a verb, it can be in any part of the sentence.

\*When identifying adverbs that modify verbs, look to see if there are any helping verbs. **You make sure that you show the adverb modifying both the helping verb and the main verb.**

\*Identify adverbs and the adjectives they modify. They are next to each other. The adverb is first, followed by the adjective.

\*Identify adverbs and the other adverbs they modify. They are next to each other, one adverb in front of the other.

\*Identify what an adverb is modifies and say whether the word modified is an adverb or an adjective.

\*Identify the same words as either adjective or adverbs, depending on what the word is modifying in the sentence.
