- 3. Paragraph 3: Describe Rainsford. Support your ideas with evidence from the text.
- 4. Paragraph 4: Compare and contrast Zaroff and Rainsford. What does this mean? Say what is similar and what is different about them! Support your ideas with evidence from the text.
