Poetry Terms of the Day

Alliteration-the repetition of sounds at the beginning of words in a line of poetry (at least two words in the line)

Assonance-the repetition of the same vowel sound in words in a line of poetry (at least two words in the line)

Consonance-the repetition of the same consonant sound in the middle or end of words in a line of poetry (at least two words per line)

Onomatopoeia-the use of words whose sounds describe their meanings
