POETRY PORTFOLIO ASSIGNMENT

DUE MONDAY, 5/23

For your portfolio, you must include the following poems. You can use any poems you have written thus far, as long as the poems are the specific types listed below.

- -1 narrative poem with 2 examples of similes, 2 examples of metaphors, and one example of hyperbole, all examples underlined (minimum 25 lines)
- -1 poem with alliteration (one example, at least two words in the line); assonance (one example, at least two words in the line); and consonance (one example, at least two words in the line) (minimum 12 lines)
- -1 poem with at least five examples of onomatopoeia, examples underlined (minimum 12 lines)
- -1 poem with at least 2 examples of personification, examples underlined (minimum 12 lines)
- -1 humorous poem in one of the three common rhyme schemes (minimum 12 lines)
- -4 biography poems (must follow specific format)
- -1 love poem on an inanimate object (minimum 12 lines)
- -3 poems of your choosing that are not listed above. These could be poems you have written (diamontes, stairs, limericks, haikus, etc.). Make sure the poems follow specific formats, if applicable.

Other Portfolio Requirements

- *You must have 13 typed or neatly written poems in your portfolio. You should dedicate one page to each type of poem, only going to another page if necessary.
- *Your portfolio must have an illustrated cover that includes an original title for your portfolio and your first and last name. You also must include a back cover, but no illustration is needed.
- *Your portfolio must include a table of contents that lists the title of each poem, the type of poem in parenthesis, and the page number of the poem.
- *The pages of your portfolio should be numbered (do not number the table of contents page).
- *All poems must have titles.



Grading

Your poems will be graded on creativity and how well they follow the formats, rules, and requirements associated with each type of poem. This will count as a test grade.
