- For the quiz in point of view, you must be able to identify the following points of view in passages: first person, second person, third person objective, third person limited, and third person omniscient.
- You also need to underline parts of the passage that tell you what point of view is being used.
- You must give an appropriate explanation of the point of view.
- Please refer to your practice sheets to see how to explain the point of views!

Examples:

First person-Narrator is a character in the story; the story is told from the narrator's perspective.

Second person-Narrator uses you/your to speak to the reader and to convey information.

Third person objective-Narrator doesn't reveal the thoughts and feelings of any of the characters.

Third person limited-Narrator reveals thoughts/feelings of one character only; Mrs. Adams is happy, cheerful, and looking forward to teaching her students.

Third person omniscient- Narrator reveals thoughts/feelings of both characters; Mrs. Adams and Ms. Settle are happy, cheerful, and looking forward to teaching their students.
