

TYPES OF CHARACTERS

Protagonist: The main character of a story.

Antagonist: A character who struggles against the main character.

Round: A round character is anyone who has a complex personality; he or she is often portrayed as conflicted or confused. He or she can be described with many different characteristics.

Flat: A flat character is the opposite of a round character. He or she only has a simple of basic personality and can be described in one way.

Dynamic: A dynamic character is someone who changes or evolves over the course of the story.

Static: A static character is someone who does **not** change over the course of the story.
