You will have to know how to do the following:

- Find simple subjects and simple predicates
- Find complete subjects and complete predicates
- Know where the subject ends and the predicate begins
- Find compound subjects and compound predicates
- Find subjects and predicates in tricky sentences (questions, here/there sentences, sentences where a prep phrase follows the subject, etc.)
- Rewrite sentences using direct address
- Rewrite sentences turning suggestions into commands

Things to remember:

- Forms of the verb to be are verbs! Some common ones are *is*, *are*, *am*, *was*, *were*.
- Be careful and check if a verb has a helping verb! They are tricky to find, especially in questions where the helping verb is often separated by the main verb!
- Make sure to review your notes, all packets, and your practice test; practice games on the website.
